The final step will be to have the whole interior of the church painted.

We will try to keep the church available as much as possible but there will be times when it will have to be closed and we will use Castletown and Ahiohill for Mass and other liturgies.

Bookings for weddings will not be affected.

Synodal Pathway - May 2022
