Review of Funeral Ministry

The guidelines for funeral ministry have been in place for over a year.

Prayers at funeral homes or homes of the deceased (Vigil for Deceased) will ordinarily be led by members of the Funeral Ministry Team on behalf of the parish.

The reception in to the church immediately before the Funeral Mass has become the norm. (approximately 15 minutes before the Mass begins)

In instances where families request that their loved one reposes in the church overnight this can be facilitated. Immediate family only may accompany the deceased. Details of such receptions will not be published. Using churches in the Diocese for 'wakes' is not permitted. **Ministers of the Word**
