# Interviews Farm Households in West Cork

People 60+ from farm households in West Cork who are receiving assistance with daily tasks (such as bathing, dressing, preparing meals, walking and eating) are invited to register interest for a 1-hour face-to-face interview to discuss the non-use of care services. These interviews will focus on those who are receiving assistance only from family members, friends and neighbours and the reasons why they do not use care services. This may be due to a lack of availability of services in their area, no need for services, and difficulty accessing services, among other reasons. This information will help us understand whether there are care needs in the
